

## Tonsure of Nuns\*



On the Third Sunday of Great Lent, 16 March 2003 (Old Style), at the Convent of the Holy Angels, Aphidnai, Attika, Sisters Jegudelia (from Kiev, Ukraine), Myrtidiotissa, Evpraxia, Archangele, and Raphaelia were tonsured to the Great Schema by His Eminence, Metropolitan Cyprian, and Sister Magdalene
