PASCHA was celebrated at the headquarters of the American Exarchate of our Church, in Etna, California, with a quiet but joyful and beautiful week of services, celebrated at the St. Gregory Palamas Monastery, the Convent of St. Elizabeth the Grand Duchess, and the parish Church of Sts.
