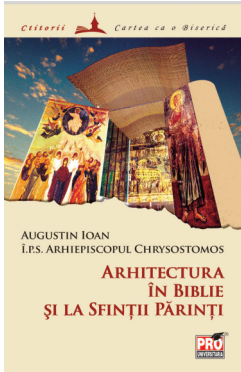


A New Publication by Two C.T.O.S. Scholars

A new book, *Arhitectura în Biblie și la Sfinții Părinți* (Architecture in the Bible and the Holy Fathers), by Augustin Ioan and His Eminence, Archbishop Chrysostomos of Etna, Exarch for the Holy Synod in America, is scheduled to be released this Fall under the imprint of the prestigious Romanian academic publisher PRO Universitaria in Bucharest, Romania.



Dr. Ioan is Professor of the History and Theory of Architecture at the Ion Mincu University of Architecture and Planning in Bucharest and a former Senior Fulbright Scholar at the College of Design, Architecture, Art, and Planning of the University of Cincinnati in Ohio. He is one of Romania's foremost architects and a writer, poet, and intellectual of considerable note. He has served as an Advisor to the Center for Traditionalist Orthodox Studies, at the St. Gregory Palamas Monastery in Etna, California, since 2004.

This new publication features, in addition to a study of architecture in the Bible by Dr. Ioan and Radu Drăgan, sometime lecturer at the École Pratique des Hautes Études at the Sorbonne, material from exchanges between Professor Ioan and Archbishop Chrysostomos on architecture and ecclesiastical art, drawn from a graduate course in Orthodox ecclesiastical art and architecture taught by both of them when His Eminence was an adjunct professor in the graduate program in Church Architecture at the Ion Mincu University, in 2005.
