

■ Praying with Reverence

The Theotokos takes pleasure in the "Salutations"*
"...and to you, rejoice!"

Father Tychon the Ascetic would say that a monk should alternate between one hour of work and one hour of prayer.

He also told of an incident that occurred in a Russian monastery regarding the Salutations to the Mother of God, for which he had great love.



"There was a monk who recited the Salutations twentyfour times every day. When he would hear the clock



strike the hour, he would begin. And indeed, each time he would repeat it with such reverence that it was if he were saying it for the first time. One day he heard a voice coming from the Icon saying: 'Rejoice, O servant; and to you, rejoice!'"

Father Tychon would also read the Salutations many times a day with tears of compunction.
