## **Opening Ceremony of the Annual Charity Shop**

n Sunday, October 30, 2017 (Old Style, commemoration of Sts. Zenobios and Zenobia), there took place the opening ceremony of the annual charity shop organized by our Holy Metropolis' charitable organization, the St. Philaret the Merciful Women's Guild, as a fund-rais-

ing effort for its multifaceted philanthropic work.

Friends, supporters, and passers-by came to the shop at its new location, which was kindly put at the disposal of our Guild free of charge by Mr. Sabbas Sabbas, and were present for the Small Blessing of the Waters, performed by His Eminence, Metropolitan Cyprian of Oropos and Phyle with the assistance of Hierodeacons Fathers Joseph and Gabriel Hagiokyprianites.

tan, to Mr. Sabbas Sabbas, and to those who worked with self-sacrifice to set up the shop.
