A Confirmation From on High
The Third Appearance of the Precious Cross
September 14, 1925

The Third Appearance of the Precious Cross took place, by the Grace of God, on the night of September 13th to the 14th, 1925 (Old Style), one year after the adoption of the Western calendar in Greece.

At the small Monastery of St. John the Theologian, in the foothills of Mt. Hymettus, near Athens, the All-Night Vigil was being served for the Feast of the Exaltation of the Precious Cross, according to the traditional Church Calendar.

Around 11:30 p.m., there appeared directly above the monastery an immense, radiant Cross, which for half an hour illumined only the Church and the crowd of the persecuted Genuine Orthodox Christians in attendance at the Vigil.

This was a “confirmation from on high” regarding the correctness of fidelity to the traditional Church Calendar, but also of the sacred struggle against the innovations introduced by the so-called ecumenical movement (from 1920 on).
