



As the Presenter, Mrs. Justina Phokianou-Gliati, reminded us: "These annual tributes were inaugurated in 1976, for the purpose of honoring our ever-memorable spiritual Father and Elder, Metropolitan Cyprian on the occasion of his Nameday."

Father Theodosios; many clergy, monks, and nuns belonging to our Holy Metropolis, and multitudes of lay people.

The approximately two-hour-long program, which the large audience followed with emotion and enthusiasm, included: • ecclesiastical hymns; • three "Prosomoia of Gratitude," written specially for this year's tribute; • a very moving film (20 minutes) with photos and videos clips of the pastoral activity of our reposed Elder and Metropolitan; • a *Spiritual*

Portrait of our ever-memorable spiritual Father and Elder, Metropolitan Cyprian, by His Grace, Bishop Klemes of Gardikion, who described the stages of spiritual growth and the spiritual gifts of our ever-memorable spiritual Father; • renditions of our ever-memorable Elder's beloved folk songs and instrumental melodies, performed by

the "Hellenorthódoxe Kleronomiá" chorus and orchestral ensemble; • distribution of a special memento.

■ In his "Closing Words of Gratitude," our Most Reverend Metropolitan fervently thanked those who labored for the realization of the greatly moving and edifying "Thanksgiving" tributes.

He expressed his pleasure that His Grace, Bishop Klemes spoke in such an edifying way about our ever-memorable spiritual Elder on the day of the twelfth anniversary of his [Bishop
