## Thirteenth Blood Drive of the Holy Metropolis of Oropos and Fili Saturday, 13.2/26.2.2022



W ith the blessing, εand encouragement of His Eminence, Metropolitan Cyprian of Oropos and Fili, the thirteenth (13th) Blood Drive of the Holy Metropolis took place at the offices of the Holy Metropolis of Oropos

and Fili on Saturday February 13th/26th 2022. The blood drive took place with the responsibility and the initiative of the Association of **"Voluntary Blood Donors '† The Crucified'** ", as well as in collaboration with the **Nea Ionia General Hospital "Konstantopouleio" (formerly "Saint Olga").** 

Although total participation was lower than usual, given the difficulties during this time period (seasonal viruses, surge in Covid-19 cases), **24 Volunteers**, **4** of which were **new Volunteers**, contributed to the collection of **22 units of blood**.

As such, we depend on the conscious effort of our Volunteer Blood Donors to participate in our Blood Drives, as well as on the efforts of those who are unable to give blood to attract new Volunteers, so that we may always have adequate supply in order to meet the dozens of requests for blood we receive annually. • Platelet donation on a regular basis is of equal importance with Blood donations.
